

ADDISON GIRLS SPORTS PROGRAM CONDUCT GUIDLEINES

SECTION 1

MANAGER CODE OF CONDUCT

- A. Managers may be subject to a criminal background check.
- B. A manager must have a minimum of two (2) adults (i.e. 1 manager and 1 coach/parent) at each practice and game. This is for your judicial safety.
- C. Managers should not transport team members to and from practices or games unless a parent consent given. If transportation is requested, then another child or adult must be present in the transportation vehicle. This is for your judicial safety.

SECTION 2

PARTICIPATION CONDUCT

- A. The umpire may eject any player, manager, coach, or spectator from the game. Ejection from the game is interpreted by the Board of AGSP as “Conduct Detrimental to the Best Interest of the League”. The ejectee is subject to suspension for one (1) or more games by quorum vote of the Board of AGSP. Unless the ejectee requests a hearing in writing within 24 hours of the ejection, the Board of AGSP will conduct or not conduct a hearing as the majority of the Board of AGSP elects. Official notice of the request for hearing delivered to any member of the Board of AGSP shall suffice. The Board of AGSP shall vote on the question of suspension. Suspension shall be served as specifically directed by the Board of AGSP.

Managers are reminded they may be permanently removed for just cause after a fair hearing and with a majority vote of the Board of AGSP. Just cause includes, but is not limited to, failure to comply with coaches and/or parents’ NYSCA Code of Ethics.

The person ejected from the game has 5 minutes to leave the park.
