## HITTING CLINIC

All Ages

Dates: June 23

Time: 10 a.m. - 1 p.m.

Cost: \$40

This camp is a 1-day clinic featuring intense instruction designed for athletes of all ages. The focus is on improving and mastering the skill of attacking and terminating the ball. Athletes will be divided into groups depending on their age and ability level.

## DE PAUL VOLLEYBALL COACHING STAFF



### AMY KLEYWEG

Head coach Amy Kleyweg and her staff have been in Lincoln Park since 2006 and in just two short years, the Blue Demon program has seen marked improvement in the BIG EAST Conference including student-athletes being named Rookie and Player of the Week and Academic All-Stars. Coach Kleyweg's first recruiting class received highest honorable mention by PrepVolleyball.com in 2006-07; while 2008 sophomore Jacie Fielder was one of the BIG EAST Conference's most consistent hitters and was one of just seven players to tally 30 kills in a contest.

Previous to joining the Blue Demon staff in February of 2006, Amy spent nine seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Denver where she coordinated all of the Pioneers' recruiting efforts and worked extensively with the team's middle hitters. During Kleyweg's tenure at Denver, she helped the Pioneers' win the school's first Sun Belt West Division Title. Kleyweg also helped mentor eight All-Sun Belt Conference players as well as the setter and newcomer of the year in 2000. An outstanding collegiate student-athlete, Kleyweg helped the University of South Florida to an impressive 78-21 overall record and two trips to the NCAA Tournament, earning berths in both 1993 and 1995.



### MEGHAN KECK

Meghan has been an assistant volleyball coach at DePaul the last two seasons and specializes in the development of setters. Working with 2008 sophomore Christy Landschoot, Keck helped Landschoot to an impressive 11.35 assists per game which ranked eighth in the BIG EAST Conference. Prior to joining the Blue Demon staff, Meghan was a volunteer assistant at Northwestern University in 2005; where she helped the Wildcats to the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Meghan also served as a team coach, private lessons director and co-director of setter training for the Lions Juniors/First Alliance Volleyball Club in Western Springs from 1998-2006. As a student-athlete at UIC, Meghan was the 2002 newcomer of the year and named the UIC Female Athlete of the Year.



### BILLY HARDISON

Billy Hardison is in his second season as a volunteer assistant coach. Hardison joins the Blue Demon staff after serving four years as an assistant coach the University of Denver from 2003-06. At Denver, Hardison worked primarily with the outside hitters and the liberos.
